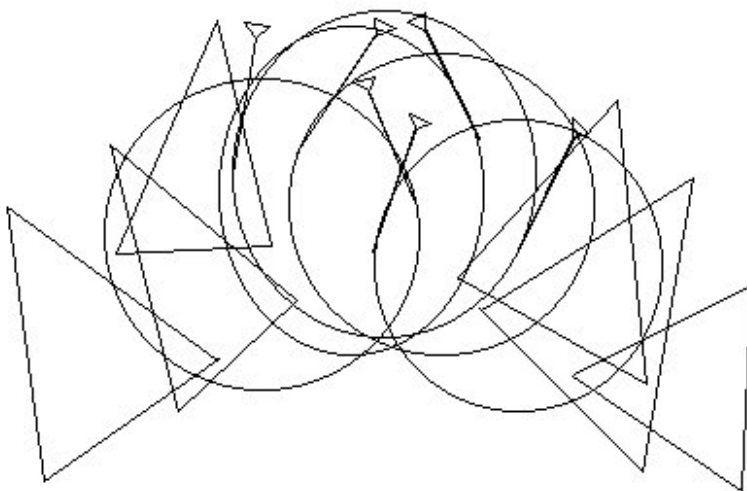

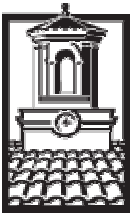

2. CD Entries will be number and judged by TAMUK brass faculty

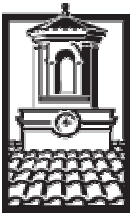
