

# *4th Annual La Joya Coyote Marching Festival*

The La Joya Independent School District and the La Joya Band Department would like to invite you and your band to participate in our Marching Festival on October 2, 2010 at La Joya Coyote Stadium. The primary purpose of this event is to provide students with an opportunity to perform in preparation for their UIL Region and Area Contests. All Bands will receive constructive feedback and comments from five accredited adjudicators. All bands will also receive ratings from all five judges on their performance. The festival will adhere to all UIL rules and regulations. The format of the festival will be a UIL Area format. We will have 3 music judges and two marching judges. Each judge will also be responsible in selecting caption awards. There will be a preliminary competition followed by a finals competition.

Trophies will be awarded for the best band in each classification, as well as second and third place trophies provided that at least 5 bands enter in each classification. At the conclusion of the Finals competition awards for outstanding woodwinds, brass, drum line and color guard, and visual effect will be awarded. The top-scoring band in Finals competition will be awarded "Grand Champion" of the Festival. Entry Fee for the Festival will be \$300.00. Deadline for all entries will be September 24, 2010. All participating bands will have a 25-minute warm up time with a 5-minute travel time from warm up areas to the stadium. Each band is allotted 15 minutes on the field of which 8 minutes will be for performance and 5 minutes to set up and 2 minutes to tear down. Bands will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis.
